Rev. Alexis Engelbrecht to Serve FCCJC in 2024

Phil Snyder, who is an Associate Regional Minister for Mid-America, shared, "I'm really excited for this position. I think it serves as a wonderful model of what good hybrid ministry can look like in the digital age."

Funds for this will come from the Gary Gonder Memorial Fund. Gary was deeply involved in the work of discipleship and small group learning experiences. He and his wife Nancy helped start and lead a group of young adults who studied the Bible in light of contemporary events over many years. Nancy shared that, "Every Thursday evening Gary would close himself up in his room and prepare for each Sunday's study." Gary knew how deeply impactful the study of the Bible is in small groups that also fellowship together. This will honor Gary's memory in a beautiful way.



CREATING VITAL CONGREGATIONS WEBINAR CONFRONTING CHRISTIAN NATIONALISM

with Dan Miller and Beau Underwood

January 17, 2024 7-8:30 p.m. ET

Co-Sponsored by The Alumni Council of Lexington Thelogical Seminary and the Reconciliation Team of the Christian Church in Kentucky

There's a growing awareness about the dangers Christian Nationalism poses to both American democracy and the message of the Gospel. How did this ideology that conflates American identity with a narrow understanding of Christianity take hold? What can be done to address it? This webinar will explore Christian Nationalism's ideas and goals, while offering some practical ways those concerned about its influence can offer a faithful counter witness to its fusion of church and state.



Dan Miller is Professor of Religion and Social Thought in the Department of Liberal Studies at Landmark College in Putney, VT. He is the author of two books, The Myth of Normative Secularism: Religion and Politics in the Democratic Homeworld (Duquesne University Press, 2016) and Queer Democracy: Desire, Dysphoria, and the Body Politic (Routledge, 2022), as well as other articles and book chapters. He is also the co-host of the popular podcast Straight White American Jesus, where he discusses issues related to Christian nationalism, Religion and American Politics, and the coded language and practices of popular American Christianity. He is also a Trauma Resolution Practitioner with the Center for Trauma Resolution and Recovery, in which capacity he serves as a coach helping individuals to process religious trauma.

Beau Underwood is the senior pastor at Allisonville Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Indianapolis, IN, a contributing editor with *Word&Way*, and a doctoral candidate in public affairs at the University of Missouri. Prior to entering congregational ministry, he worked in progressive faith-based advocacy in Washington, D.C. He is the co-author (with Brian Kaylor) of the forthcoming book from Chalice Press: Baptizing America: How Mainline Protestants Helped Build Christian Nationalism.
