God Is Always Faithful

Dr. Jim Hill Interim Senior Minister

Times of transition are always challenging for us. It is certainly no different when churches are seeking God's will concerning the calling of a new pastor. I began my ministry as your interim senior minister a little over four months ago. When your Search Committee invited me to serve your congregation, they asked me to lead the church family through the *Intentional Interim Ministry* process. This process includes a brief self-study designed to help the congregation take a fresh look at itself and prepare for the calling of a new minister. This study involves five *focus points* – heritage, mission, leadership, connections, and the future. The intentional interim ministry process is designed to allow the congregation to complete a significant portion of the study prior to beginning their search for a new minister. The feedback from the congregation on the focus points helps the committee complete a church profile and enables them to have a better idea what to look for as they prepare to recommend a new pastor. The process also helps the congregation be better prepared to engage a new minister when the minister is called.

The Search Committee has been doing an excellent job leading the congregation through the intentional interim process. The Strategic Planning event held recently at the park was a part of this process and allowed the congregation to reflect on and give feedback to both the Strategic Planning Committee and the Search Committee as we examined the "mission" focus point. On Friday evening, November 5, the Search Committee will be hosting a Heritage Event for the entire church family as we explore "the Story" of First Christian Church. We will have ice cream and explore together the wonderful history of this congregation. I hope you will plan now to be present for this event. The Search Committee will also be recommending some actions to help clarify the congregation's leadership and staff structure during the coming weeks. These steps will allow the church to complete most of the intentional interim self-study and begin completing the church profile. A congregational survey will be shared with congregation to allow every member to provide input regarding the calling of a new senior ministry.

All of us would like to see the process move quickly, but most congregations need at least nine to twelve months to complete the process and call a new pastor. It is not unusual for the interim period to be a stressful time for the congregation. People get anxious during times of uncertainty. Obviously, the last year and a half has been a particularly stressful time for all of us as we have been forced to deal with the reality of the pandemic. That makes this timeframe an especially stressful time for our church family. Not only are we grieving and adjusting to the loss of a pastor, but we are dealing with all the changes necessary because of the pandemic. People may become frightened, frustrated, angry, and confused. It is important to remember when we feel these things that we are not alone. God is always with us. God has been faithful to the generations of church members who preceded us at First Christian Church, and I am confident God will be faithful to us as well. I look forward to worshipping with you on the Lord's Day.
